

Channel Erosion Repairs on Dry Gully Louetta Road to Northbridge Drive



In an effort to keep you informed about the Harris County Flood Control District's continuing improvements in the Dry Gully and Cypress Creek watersheds, we want to notify you of an upcoming project in your area.

In January 2017, the Flood Control District will begin erosion repairs in northern Harris County on a tributary of Cypress Creek known as Dry Gully and formally identified as HCFCD Unit K133-00-00.

Surveys have identified severe channel erosion along the 2,000-foot-long segment of the channel from Louetta Road upstream to Northbridge Drive. The project will repair the channel slopes, armor the bottom of the channel with buried riprap, re-grade existing backslope interceptor swales, and replace damaged outfall pipes. The project will reclaim proper maintenance access to this drainage channel, while also working to protect and save select trees growing in Flood Control District right of way.

Construction equipment will access the work area at Louetta Road and Northbridge Drive. The contractor will use heavy construction equipment such as dump trucks, backhoes and bulldozers. The Flood Control District appreciates your patience and understanding through the duration of this project.
